


FORD MUSTANG MACH-E

MAKING MUSTANG MACH-E MOVE: THE ALL-ELECTRIC POWERTRAIN



FRONT ELECTRIC MOTOR

Placed in line with the front axle on Mustang Mach-E models equipped with AWD, this is the secondary unit providing power to the front wheels.

2 HIGH-VOLTAGE BATTERY

Located below the floor and between the front and rear wheels, all energy required to power the vehicle is stored in this battery.

REAR ELECTRIC MOTOR

Placed in line with the rear axle, this is the primary unit providing power to the rear wheels.

CHARGE PORT

Enables the battery to be charged using an external source. The Charge Port can be connected to domestic power outlets or higher power public charging points.
